A) Terms and conditions

- 1. Food and beverage is only permitted for specific trade shows and conventions directly related to the food and beverage industry.
- A detailed list of the products that will be sampled (quantities included) must be submitted to the Centre two
 weeks prior to the scheduled event.
- All sampling must comply with the Food Act 1983, Hazard Analysis Critical Control Points (HACCP) and the Centre's guidelines outlined below:
 - a) Beverage tasting and promotional samples are limited to a maximum size of 50ml per glass/cup
 - b) Solid food portions shall not be larger than BITE SIZE portions 85g
 - c) A non-halal sign or placard must be prominently displayed for all sampling products that are not halal certified.
 - d) Sampling of non halal products which contain pork or pork derived products is strictly prohibited and cannot be brought into the Centre at all.
 - e) Eating and drinking utensils provided by exhibitors/ sponsor shall be of recyclable materials (e.g. disposable Eco cutlery, biodegradable wooden cutlery) and must not be reused
 - f) Food must be offered in a ready to consume manner to avoid it being handled by the public. Food should be apportioned and served with toothpicks or other appropriate utensils or containers
 - g) Antiseptic solutions should be made available for visitors wishing to clean their hands prior to and after sampling
 - h) Exhibitor or sponsor shall comply with all local health and safety regulations and shall bear all costs related to such compliance. This includes but not limited to provision of sink installation. Exhibitor or sponsor shall remove any unauthorised item or items that did not meet the conditions above stated
 - i) Exhibitor or sponsor shall provide separate bin for disposal of food waste and shall ensure that all food waste are disposed properly. Furthermore, they must ensure that no containers, toothpick and non-food waste is disposed in the bin allocated for food waste
 - j) If at any time, an activity or operation is considered non-compliant, unsafe or poses any risks to any persons or the environment, the Centre's representatives shall have the right to immediately postpone or cancel the activity until the issue is rectified. Please note that at any stage before or after this permit is approved, the Centre may at its sole and absolute discretion add or remove any restrictions to the use or application of this permit.
- 4. The undersigned hereby agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Centre from and against any and all claims, demands, actions, suits, losses, costs, charges, expenses, damages and liabilities whatsoever which the Centre may pay, sustain, suffer or incur by reason of or in connection with the Exhibitor and/or Sponsor's food and beverage samples at the Centre.
