KLIA Express Rail Link (ERL)



The KLIA Express: Your Non-Stop City Link

The KLIA Express whisks you directly between KLIA2, KLIA, and KL Sentral (Kuala Lumpur's main downtown station) in a mere 28 minutes (from KLIA) or 33 minutes (from KLIA2). Settle into spacious seats, enjoy onboard digital entertainment, and utilize wheelchair-accessible areas and luggage racks for a stress-free trip. With departures every 15 minutes during peak hours and every 20 minutes during off-peak hours, you'll never have to wait too long for your train.

Public Transport to Kuala Lumpur Convention Centre: A

Traveling to the Centre from Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) is a breeze with a combination of the KLIA Ekspres and the Light Rail Transit (LRT) system. Here's how to get there:

Step 1: Take the KLIA Ekspres to KL Sentral

- Hop on the KLIA Ekspres train from either KLIA terminal (KLIA or KLIA2). This high-speed train whisks you directly to KL Sentral, Kuala Lumpur's main transportation hub, in just 28 minutes (not 45 minutes).

Step 2: Transfer to the LRT Kelana Jaya Line

- Once at KL Sentral, navigate to the LRT station. Look for the Gombak-bound train on the Kelana Jaya Line (usually blue line signage).

Step 3: Disembark at KLCC LRT Station

- Your ride on the LRT takes about 10-15 minutes, depending on traffic. Keep an eye out for the KLCC LRT station announcement.

Step 4: Walk to the Centre

- Exit the KLCC LRT station and head down to the concourse level. Look for the pedestrian tunnel connecting Suria KLCC, the mall below the Petronas Twin Towers. This tunnel is located between a Maybank and a Guardian pharmacy. Follow the signs or ask for directions if needed. A short walk through the tunnel will lead you right to the Centre.

Purchase a Coupon: Upon arrival at KLIA, head to the designated Airport Limo counters conveniently located at:

- International Arrival Hall (just after Customs, before the public arrival area)
- Domestic Arrival Hall (public area after Domestic Baggage Clearance)
- Domestic Baggage Reclaim, Arrival Level

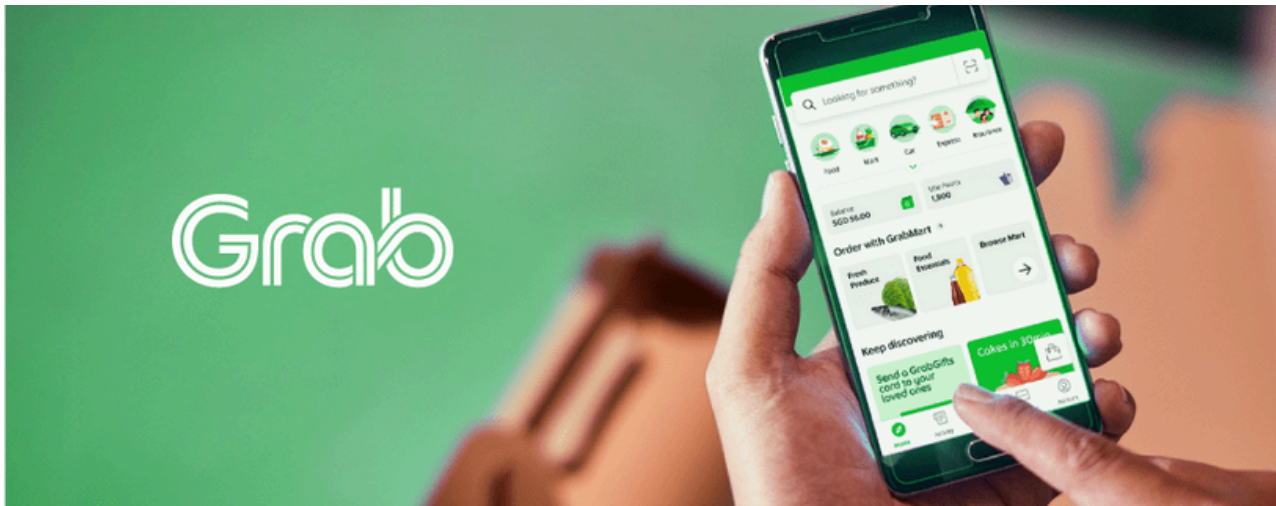

E-Hailing App: GRAB



International travelers looking for a convenient and potentially budget-friendly way to get around after landing at Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) can consider using ride-hailing apps.

Here's how it works:

Download a Ride-Hailing App: Before your trip, download a popular ride-hailing app like Grab onto your smartphone.

Designated Pick-Up Points: Once you've cleared customs and collected your luggage, head to the designated pick-up point for ride-hailing services.

KLIA Main Terminal: Gate 3 & 4, Level 1 (available since August 1st, 2019)

KLIA2: Transportation Hub, Level 1, gateway@klia2 (available since July 1st, 2019)

Request Your Ride: Open your chosen app and book your ride to your desired destination within Kuala Lumpur or Selangor.

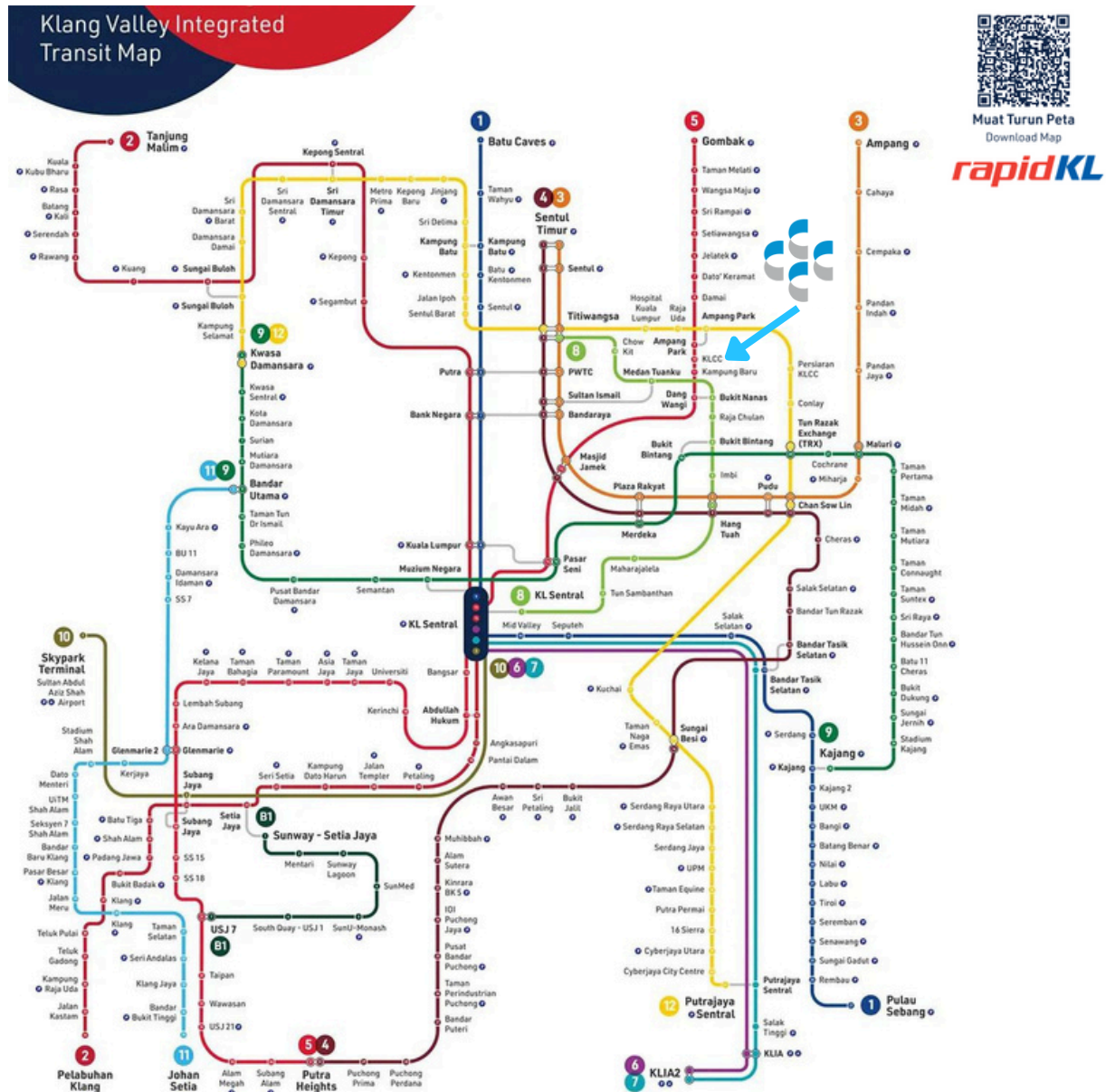

KLIA Express Rail Link (ERL)



KL has a remarkably well-connected Klang Valley Integrated Transit System, making it easy to get around quickly and efficiently.

This extensive network comprises various train systems and routes:

Light Rail Transit (LRT): A network of light rail lines covering major areas within Kuala Lumpur and its suburbs.

Mass Rapid Transit (MRT): Lines covering longer distances within the Klang Valley region.

Monorail: A single elevated loop line connecting key landmarks within the Kuala Lumpur city center.



KLIA Express Rail Link (ERL)



Go KL City Bus (FREE City Shuttle)

Go KL City Bus is a free bus service that serves the city Centre of Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. With six bus routes within the city and 28 stops, journey within the capital city of Malaysia is made easy.

Here's how to get to Centre using this convenient service:

- **Catch the Green Line:** This specific Go KL City Bus route is the one you want.
- **Disembark at KLCC:** Keep your eyes peeled for the KLCC bus stop located right in front of Suria KLCC's entrance facing Jalan Ampang.
- **Walk the Tunnel:** Head down to the concourse level. Look for the pedestrian tunnel connecting Suria KLCC, the mall below the Petronas Twin Towers. This tunnel is located between a Maybank and a Guardian pharmacy. Follow the signs or ask for directions if needed. A short walk through the tunnel will lead you right to the Centre.
